PM	911 Memorial Museum: Serving as the principal institution for examining the implications of the events of 9/11, documenting their impact and exploring the continuing significance of the events in modern history.

AM	Harlem Civil Rights walking tour: the story of Harlem’s impact on the American Civil Rights Movement of the 1950s and 1960s
PM	Liberty Island, Ellis Island and the Immigration Museum: travel by ferry, past the Statue of Liberty, to Ellis Island, which from 1892 to 1924, was America's largest and most active immigration station, where over 12 million immigrants were processed.

PM	<p>National Museum of African American History and Culture: the only national museum devoted exclusively to the documentation of African American life, art, history and culture</p> <p>Free time for shopping</p>

AM	<p>The Pentagon: guided tour of the Headquarters of the Department of Defense, located in a massive five-sided concrete and steel building that is a potent symbol of America's military strength.</p>
PM	<p>Arlington National Cemetery: the final resting place for many of the USA's greatest heroes, including more than 300,000 veterans of every American conflict, from the Revolutionary War to Iraq and Afghanistan.</p> <p>Transfer to the airport for your flight back to the UK</p>
